## The Tefilah Series

### The Friday Night Book and The Shabbat Morning Book (for Tefilah)

The Tefilah series reinforces the reading skills learned in the Read Hebrew curriculum using a selection of prayers from the Kabbalat Shabbat and Shabbat Morning Services.

#### **Three Sections**

The *Friday Night Book* and *The Shabbat Morning Book* are divided into three main sections:

- The Contents Page - lists the prayers to be studied
- The Review Section – reviews letters, vowels, reading skills and rules to remember
- The Prayer Section – features eight prayers presented on a four page spread

#### **Studying the Prayers**

Each prayer is presented in a four page spread to allow for:

- Reading practice and skill review using the 'Reading Skills Checklist'
- Understanding key words
- Recognizing phrases and patterns
- Fluent reading and chanting of the prayer

Page 1: Reading Practice – Students read lines with words from the prayer and complete the Reading Skills Checklist using the prayer on the next page.

Page 2: Prayer Page #1 – This is a working copy of the prayer to be used for reading practice and for writing beans and baskets.

Page 3: Recognize and Understand – Students learn the general meaning of the prayer based on the theme and key words, phrases and patterns that are listed. The goals are to build a sight word vocabulary and present the main idea.

Page 4: Prayer Page #2 – The second copy of the prayer is intended to serve as a clean page for fluent (error-free) reading and for chanting the prayer.
