

## Sarah, David and *YOU* Read Hebrew

*Sarah, David and You Read Hebrew* is a five book curriculum that teaches reading and writing. As a system, the first three books teach HOW to read (letters, vowels, reading skills). The last two books teach the remaining letters and REINFORCE the skills that have been learned.

Both the design features and reading drills should be used as teaching tools.
